




Summer 2024 Temperature and Precipitation


Departure from Normal Temperature (F) 6/1/2024 - 8/31/2024

Summer Heat Dome 2023 vs. 2024




Summer 2024 Recap


- Seventh-hottest summer on record across Texas
- Temperatures averaged 2 degrees above normal
 - Summer 2023 temperatures averaged 4 degrees above normal
- Statewide, rainfall averaged near the long-term average
- Austin had 30 days at 100 degrees or higher
 - Austin in 2023 had 69 days at 100 degrees or higher

September Temperature and Precipitation


Departure from Normal Temperature (F) 9/1/2024 - 9/30/2024



Departure from Normal Precipitation (in) 9/1/2024 - 9/30/2024




October 2024: ENSO Neutral in Place




La Niña Expected to Develop This Fall






La Niña Impacts





An Unusual September Jet Stream Pattern







NOAA's October Outlook







NOAA's October-December Outlook

Fall and Winter Weather Outlook

- Fall weather forecast to be warmer than normal with below-normal rainfall
- Temperature forecast to average between 1 and 2 degrees above normal
- Winter weather shaping up to be milder than normal with continued below-normal rainfall
- Expect some periods of cold weather, but no sustained cold
- La Niña forecast to end sometime next spring
